

Killer "Cherry" Tomato Navy Gunnery Target Balloons Information and Instructions



"Killer Tomatoes"®* introduces the
"Cherry Tomato" target balloon.

NSN-6920-CHERRY-

Our "Cherry Tomato" naval gunnery target balloon - air inflated, orange, 60"x 60" x 60" (5'x5'x5') when inflated, made with 12 mil PVC, includes a stainless steel metal "D" rings for tie down. A 25' long floating trip line for recovery purposes comes already attached to a "D" ring on the side of the balloon. The "Cherry Tomato" is the newest member of our family. Intended to be used for small arms target practice.

General Instructions

1. Place the balloon on the deck where there aren't sharp objects, and where the balloon can be tied down after inflation. A 10+ square foot clear area makes the job go better.
2. Unfold and position the balloon with the black fill tube up.
3. Insert the blower and begin inflation. **(See figure 1)**
4. At the same time secure balloon to the deck with using rope attached to the "D" ring.
5. Do not over inflate. The balloon should be full, but not bulging. A correctly filled balloon measures about 6 feet in height.
6. Disconnect the air source, twist and fold the fill tube and secure with the cable tie included or a length of line.

Warning: Over inflation will damage the target balloon.

The floating trip/recovery line attached to the side of the balloon should not be used for towing.

Hold the fill tube closed by hand during full operation.

****Note that a plastic drop cloth should be used to avoid damage to the target balloon during inflation.**

*****Water maybe added for ballast if needed.**
